Good news! Due to recent legislation you are **no longer required** to register or maintain a DUNS (Data Universal Numbering System) number or SAM (System for Award Management) registration. Effective March 28, 2018, landowners and producers who participate as a legal entity in NRCS conservation programs are now **exempt**.
