Weeds to WATCH! Myrtle Spurge (*Euphorbia myrsinites*)

This noxious State and County B Listed weed contains a toxic milky sap that can cause severe skin irritations and burns and is poisonous if ingested.

If you wish to remove Myrtle Spurge, you should wear gloves, long sleeves and eye protection. The plants, along with root fragments, should be bagged and put in the trash.
